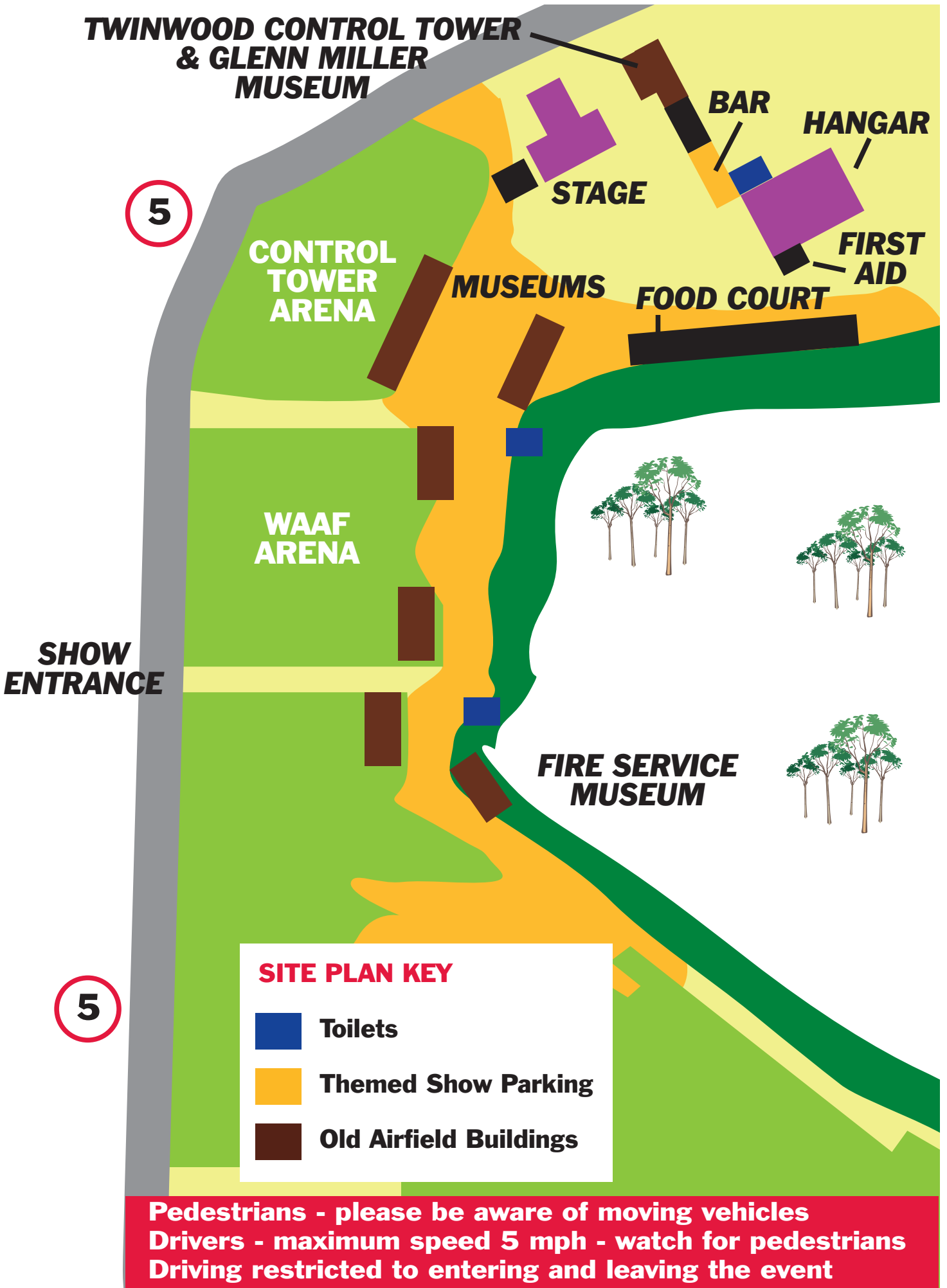

TWINWOOD

RAF Twinwood Farm is a former World War 2 airfield. It opened in mid 1941 when the RAF began to use the grassed field. By April 1942 it had three concrete runways and additional temporary buildings. From then until the end of the war the planes of No 51 Operational Training Unit used 'Twinwoods'. In 1944 the base was transferred to the U.S. Eighth Air Force. Twinwood Airfield was where the band leader USAAF Major Glenn Miller took off on 15 December 1944 in a plane bound for Paris. His plane disappeared over the English Channel and he was never seen again. The airfield closed in June 1945.

- The Glenn Miller Museum is located in the restored control tower and features displays about Glenn Miller, RAF Twinwood Farm, and World War II. Other buildings house different displays including:
- Twinwood Aviation Museum - featuring uniforms and artifacts recovered from German and Allied aircraft crash sites, as well as British aviation units and life in Britain during the war.
- Rooms of a 1940s family home
- WAAF barracks
- Fire Service Museum - recreated 1940s wartime fire station with uniforms, equipment and vehicles
- Displays of military vehicles
